Tuneful Trebles: Rising 3-8 grade. **Week 1: June 27-July 1** and **Week 2: Tues. July 5-8** Morning only 8:30 to 11:30am.

Each week will focus on ensemble participation, singing techniques, percussion and Orff instruments and dance/movement. Basic music theory, sight reading and ear-training will be covered with a performance at the end of each session.
